





CLIMATE ACTION MONTH - INAUGURAL FUNCTION

Month long Initiative aims to raise environmental awareness and foster sustainable practices. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Agurchand Manmull Jain College was collaborated with Citizen Consumer and Civic Action Group (CAG) Chennai, for a "Climate Action Month – July 2023" (CAM-2023) was inaugurated at Parasmal Chordia Seminar Hall.

CAM -2023 is an awareness campaign amongst educational institutions across Chennai, on the causes and mitigation of the climate change. CAM will encompass series of programs, competitions, and expert talks to raise awareness about environmental degradation and to promote alternative and sustainable practices among the student population by engaging and empowering them.

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ALTERNATIVES FOR SINGLE USE PLASTICS - ADZAP COMPETITION

Citizen Consumer and Civic Action Group along with the IQAC of Agurchand Manmull Jain College organised an Adzap competition [Theme-Alternatives for single use plastics] for the students of Shift I and Batch I of Shift II as a part of the Climate Action Month on 3rd July 2023. It was the continuation of the inaugural program which was held on 1st July 2023 at Parasmal Chordia Seminar Hall in the college campus. The programme began with prayer followed by the welcome address by the CAG member, Ms. Madhuvanthi, Researcher – Environment & Climate Action and Solid Waste Management. It was followed by a talk by Ms. Ann Anra, senior Marketing strategist.

She elaborated on sustainable fashion and emphasized on recycling, reusing clothes and scraps in the most efficient way to achieve sustainability. Subsequently there was a documentary presentation by Mr. Afroz, Researcher – Environment & Climate Action and Solid Waste Management. His documentary gave an insight into the everyday life of a used clothes collector, Laddu Bhai, from North Madras.

There was an interactive session with Mr. Laddu Bhai. He shared his experiences in collecting used clothes and the need for repurposing them. Students actively participated in the Question-and-Answer session that followed. The Adzap competition began after the formal introduction of the Judges, Dr. S. Ananthakrishnan, Head, Department of History, from Shift I, Mr. Fenn Mosses, Assistant Professor of Visual communication, Shift II and Mrs. Muthulakshmi, Assistant Professor from Marketing Management, Shift II. Thirteen teams participated in the competition and the results were announced by the judges at the end of the competition. The first prize was bagged by A.K. Aishwarya and team of B.A. English. 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DOCUMENTRY SCREENING ON PLASTICS AND DISCUSSION

A programme related to documentary screening and discussion on Plastics was organised by Citizen Consumer and Civic Action Group (CAG) in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Agurchand Manmull Jain College. This programme was conducted on 18th July 2023 at Parasmal Chordia Seminar Hall. The programme started with the college prayer and tamilthaivazhtu. One of the IQAC members, Dr.V.Nalina welcomed the speaker and the gathering. A total of 83 participants including 77 students (53 boys, 24 girls) attended the programme. The programme was initiated by Mr. Afroz, Researcher - Environment & Climate Action and Solid Waste Management. He spoke about the impacts of plastics usage. His research work involves creating audio visual material related to environment. He believes that talking to people through art forms of videos will be very effective in reaching them with simplified message. In this context, as the main part of the program, he displayed the detailed documentary video on the impact of plastic usage across the world. At the end of the documentary video, the students actively participated in the discussion. Several doubts were asked by students and an elaborate explanation was given by Mr. Afroz. He insisted in the minimal use of single use plastic. Further, he pointed out that recycle is a myth and requested to move towards zero waste environments. All the participants chanted the slogan 3R's, "Refuse, Reduce, Reuse" of plastics. IQAC coordinator, Dr.V.S.Murali applauded the involvement of the student participants in climate action month programmes. Vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. V. Nalina followed by National anthem.

Citizen Consumer and Civic Action Group along with the IQAC of Agurchand Manmull Jain College organised a month-long event in Agurchand Manmull Jain College as a part of the Climate Action Month (CAM) during July 2023.

In connection with CAM 23 on 28th July, a mega carnival "Kuppai Thiruvizha" event organised to bring together entrepreneurs and experts to promote zero waste and plastic free lifestyles. The programme started with α brief introduction of events that took place in the college during the CAM by Dr. V.S. Murali -**IOAC** Coordinator, the Principal Dr. N. Venkataramanan welcomed the gathering. Mr. Afroz, of CAG spoke about CAG and Kuppai Thiruvizha. To bring awareness to the students a talk on waste segregation was made by Mr. Karthikeyan of Urbaser.

In line with the sustainability goal, a mega art from waste event was also organised which focused on collection, segregation, and mass production of upcycled art works from solid wastes. Towards this a campus cleaning programme was organised by the college where in many students which include – NSS Students from shift I and students from all the departments of Shift II took part and mobilized huge wastes by segregating them at source.

During the programme Mr. Murali of No Food Waste – Chennai chapter explained to students on food waste made by individuals in the society and the need to provide food to those who are deprived of getting a single meal per day and explained the role played by them for the same.

The Black Boys team played the CAM Anthem and entertained the students through singing the songs which carried the message of environmental sustainability to the audience. During the period the students belonging to Art and Culture Club of Agurchand Manmull Jain College displayed their talent in singing and dancing to entertain the audience.

A Mime event was organised for communicating the message of theme of the event by Mr. Prakash and team.

Over 4000 visitors attended a carnival on zero waste products was organised, where about 30 vendors displayed the zero waste products which was well received by the students, faculty members and visitors.

The Programme started at 10.00 a.m. in the morning and closed at 4.00 p.m. Mr. Shankar of CAG explained the key take away to the students from the programme and proposed a formal vote of thanks in the valedictory function of the carnival.
