GRADUATION DAY REPORT

Agurchand Manmull Jain College organized its 47th Graduation Day for the students of batch 2018 -2021 on Monday, the 30th of January 2023 at 10.00 a.m.in Bhagavan Shri Mahavir Gyan Bhavan Auditorium. 1560 graduands from UG and PG were present in the ceremony.

The Graduation ceremony started with the academic procession of the dignitaries Bhavanesh Kumar Deora, Shri. Surendra Kumar Gadiya, Dean Dr.M.M.Ramya, Principal Dr.N.Venkataramanan, Chief Guest Mr. Josh Foulger, Managing Director, Bharat FIH Limited, Special Guest Sundar Sethuraman, CEO, Purple Drive Technologies and the Facilitators of all the departments. The Graduation Day was declared open by Shri. Bhavanesh Kumar Deora, the Management committee member.

The college report was presented by the Dean Dr. M.M Ramya, highlighting the growth of the college with a student strength of more than 9000 students in 24 Undergraduate and 4 Postgraduate programs. The report emphasized the educational development schemes for meritorious students and the induction of 3 new Postgraduate courses, 1 new Undergraduate course and 120 value added courses. The College had a fruitful year of placements and internships with 43 placement drives.

Mr.Josh Foulger the Chief Guest, spoke about the expectations on the youngsters in today's demanding industry. He insisted in the realization that, the students have to always update themselves about the recent developments pertaining to their industry. He asked the graduands to focus and strive towards AMRITKAAL- a journey towards making India developed country. He stressed on the role of students in developing the economy of India through their contribution from 'ME' to 'WE'. The youngsters must prepare themselves to face the challenges in this unstable world, and we as a country must run to stand strong. The second challenge that the Chief Guest spoke was on VUCA - (Volatile, Unpredictable, Complex, Ambiguous). The Covid 19 Pandemic was a Black Swan event and the whole world was hit by this rare event. He also said that the youngsters must be ready to adapt to the new changes that come in their way and move on towards success. He spoke about the three-pillar model required for the success of any institution which are 1. IQ-Intelligence Quotient, 2. EQ-Emotional Quotient and 3. GQ- God Quotient- values in doing the right thing at the right time for the right reason. He concluded the speech by wishing the graduands success in their career. The degree certificates were distributed by the Chief Guest and the 47th graduation day was dissolved by Dean and ended with the National Anthem.

THE ROLE AND FUNCTION OF MOD IN INDIA'S HIGHER DEFENCE ORGANISATION

The speaker was Smt. Uma Maheswari R, Director, Armed Forces Headquarters Civil Service, Ministry of Defence. The seminar was focused on the structure and organization of the Ministry of Defence. She highlighted the importance and need of armed forces and shared her work experience. She spoke about the origin of the Ministry of Defence and emphasized on the functions of the various departments under the Ministry of Defence. She also spoke on the role of the armed forces in protecting the nation and suggested the students to take up career in Defence as it is the largest employer in India. The session was ended with the major highlights of the Ministry of Defence 2022 and an interaction with the students.

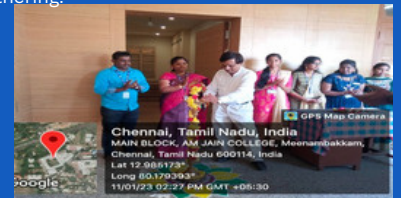
